- Young men's t-shirts (pull over, round neck, assorted colors/adult sizes L, XL, XXL)
- Hoodies, men & women (size M, L, XL, and XXL)
- Stocking caps
- Gloves/Mittens
- Sweat pants for male and female (same size guidelines as jeans)
- Lip balm
- Hair brushes
