

Discovery Place Preschool offers a summer camp each year. The summer camp is held in June, July and the first part of August. Summer camp is offered to children ages 18 months through 10 years of age. Our summer camp includes age appropriate activities such as play time, art projects, science experiments, lunch (provided by parents), outdoor/gym recess, monthly water play days, special exciting visitors (think Mad Science and magic shows for example), and more. We split the classes by age groups up to 5 years old and we combine our school age children ages 6 to 10. Almost everything we do is in house; we do not venture out for field trips with the exception of neighborhood nature walks for our older students.

Summer camp will be held on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings beginning June 4th. The summer daily schedule will be drop off at 8:45 AM and pick up at 12:15 PM. Summer camp registration requires a \$25 activity fee to help cover some of the visitors and activities we will be doing. This fee is non-refundable and required in order to complete registration for the summer program. Please note that if you are new to the program or returning from previous years, you need to fill out a new registration form to enroll for summer. **We have to close the preschool July 9-11 for Vacation Bible School, so the August week is complimentary.

Over the past years, we have noticed that our students get the most benefit out of our program when they are enrolled 2 or 3 days per week vs. 1 day per week. It helps with consistency, building friendships and picking up new concepts. Our staff is busy planning and brainstorming great ideas for the summer program and we are looking forward to a fun-filled summer!
