Homeless and at-risk youth are offered much-needed services at VOA's Youth Resource Center in Salt Lake City. At first, individuals may come to the YRC for a shower, to do laundry or get some food. But once trust is built, the Center is able to serve them in more meaningful ways, breaking down barriers that led to homelessness and allowing teens to transform their lives. Each year the YRC serves about 800 homeless/at-risk teens. They offer emergency shelter beds, 24/7 assistance, three meals a day and free legal services through their Homeless Youth Legal Clinic. Also offered is programming dedicated to education assistance, job training, counseling, and various volunteer-run groups.
